





Farming a Sustainable Bioeconomy



The 2025 GFFA will address the issue of „Farming a Sustainable Bioeconomy“.

Our global economic system is facing great challenges as it is largely dependent on nonrenewable, fossil resources. A sustainable, circular bioeconomy can play a key role in the further development towards a sustainable and resilient resource base.

The bioeconomy transition has great potential, saves resources and provides new sources of income. This paradigm shift must go hand in hand with protecting human rights based approaches and the progressive realisation of the right to adequate food, and must respect the limits of ecosystems.

Global bioeconomy can directly contribute towards achieving eleven of the seventeen United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)




